Dear Maria

As I finished my letter
a few days since, we were about
starting to the front, the Advance was
only a reconnoissance, to ascertain
whether arms, the Enemy were in this
vicinity - we only went out eight or ten
miles but found nothing of them &
returned the next morning. Yesterday
I made my report to Col Gourdon of
all that transpired during the time
I was in command and he told me
he had complimented the 9th and
myself for our actions on the 2^d and
since but the Artillery officers were
curious and I think our Capt will
be court-martialed. The Enemy no
doubt intends to capture the whole
Reg't and admits this disappointment
we have got about 45 - missing - 13
were wounded and five killed - I am
within two inches of getting hit in the
head and many balls passed very near
me I am thankful that my life
is still spared - I am now occupying
an old salt house for my bed &c -
and am as comfortable as need be
there are a thousand little incidents
that I might relate but my time
is now limited for I never
new mercury - arrived day before yesterday
