

Camp of 12th W. V. M.
Wof. Run Shoals Va
April 14th 1863.

My dear Mary: You see we are still
here, but we are preparing to move as
fast as possible. Today we are sending
in every thing but shelter tents -

I wish you could have stayed here
a little longer - you + Mrs. Nichols +
Mrs. Vaughan, but on the whole it is
for the best that you went when you
did. I will try to see you when I can -
I will either have you come out to
us or will go to see you if possible.

I dont know when we shall move
but soon without doubt. I think you
had better stay about Washington until
it is settled that you cannot come to
us again - Capt. Ormisher

I send by Mr. Peach a picture that
I had taken this morning. I want
you to take good care of it -

Write as often as you can - Write by
Mr. Peach when he comes out -
