June 29th 1863.
Monday.

Dear Mary:

We have reached this place this morning after a hard march thro' the mud & rain. We have been here an hour & it is now one o'clock.

There are several Corps here, all mixed up & we shall stop an hour or two and then on again - I don't know where we shall turn up, but, as the boys say, they can't keep us but about four days more. Nobody knows where Lee is, or where we are going.

Hooker is removed from the command & Genl. Meade of the 5th Corps is at present in temporary command - So we are told -
