Dear Mother Sisters and Brothers I received your letter of the 7<sup>th</sup> Sept in due time also the money I answered the letter the 11<sup>th</sup> and put it in the mail with the letter containing the 12 dollars you ought to received them both the same time it was lucky that you got the one with the money I recd your letter dated the 18<sup>th</sup> yesterday As you did not get my other letter I will write some that wrote before We joined the regt near Munsions Hill then moved back here and camped shall stay here until we get recruited and get some new horses my old horse I left at Warrenton all used up and bunged up Then took another to ride here and used him up by the time we got to Manassas There I left
