Mans of the go is here - I was glad to hear from you - I am truly glad if Gov. H. has fixed it so I can get away from old W.L. I hope he will conclude to give me the 11th if he does I will do something for you. Our being might be used to the Gov. in my favor is the fact that Gen. Braxton in his report of the battle of Savage Station mentions my name handsomely, & did not mention the name of any other Officer in this Rgt. - that would help me if Fredericks knew it - if there is anything you can do or say for me do so & I will make it all right - for another point of a big man here - don't tell what it is, you will hear in few days - The Box has not come to hand yet - it will arrive all right I have no doubt thank you for it - Dr. Lawton sends his regards - Write as soon as you get this & let me know if you hear anything - I will send a recommend for you ^{to} ~~to~~ Gov. H. signed by self & others - will send it by this mail.
