Sunday 10 o'clock A.M.

My Dear Sister -

I am on board
the "Elm City" about half way
between New Haven and N.Y.
We are to land at Jersey City
and that is the most we
know, whether we are proceed
immediately to Washington or

know. We started from our
camp at Brattleboro last
night about 5 o'clock, the
cars left the depot about 9 and
we got here and came on
board about 6 this morning.
