

Camp at Union Mills Va  
Sunday Apr. 26<sup>th</sup> 1863

Dear Sister —

We were paid off for 4 months last night. Enclosed I send you some scrip which they make change to us in.  I wanted you to see it just for the curiosity of the thing. When the Paymaster handed the Capt<sup>t</sup> three or four sheets of it, Capt<sup>t</sup> asked him if he would 'no just as soon take one of them back & give him a Card of ginger-bread. — I shall send a Paymasters check as I did before, tomorrow or next day. —

It is almost time for Grand Mount & as I am on the Camp Guard to day I will close —
