My Darling Wife I got a long &
good letter from you yesterday
with the one from Mrs Triff.

Am rejoiced you care so well
& love me so much. I went to
Washington Friday night & returned
Sat. morn - or I would have
sent a letter Saturday.

No Darling, those letters are of
no great consequence - I wanted
to see whether I paid \$10. to
Col. Proctor or Fred. again.
And the letter you sent is sufficient
evidence that I paid it to the Col.
I should like to see the order
I spoke of, however but do not
trouble yourself about it.

We are nicely situated here,
like better than at Fairfax Station.
