Va. July 27th 1862

Dear Father

yours of the 21st came to hand in due time and was gladly received by me and indeed it always give me pleasure to get a letter from you and to know that the folks are all well there.

I am well as usual and able to eat my allowance. Everything is quiet here at present and we shall probably remain here for the next month or so. I have no further news of any of the boys that were sick and wounded that I wrote in my last. I received a letter this morn from Nathan, he is well and stands soldiers life
