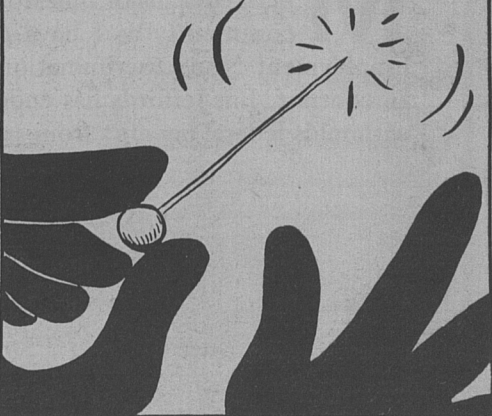

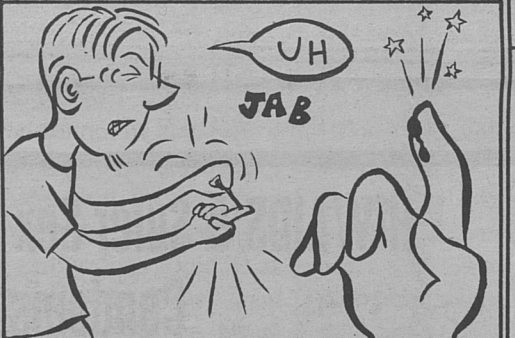

AN OLD CONFLICT HAS REARED IT'S UGLY FACE AGAIN.

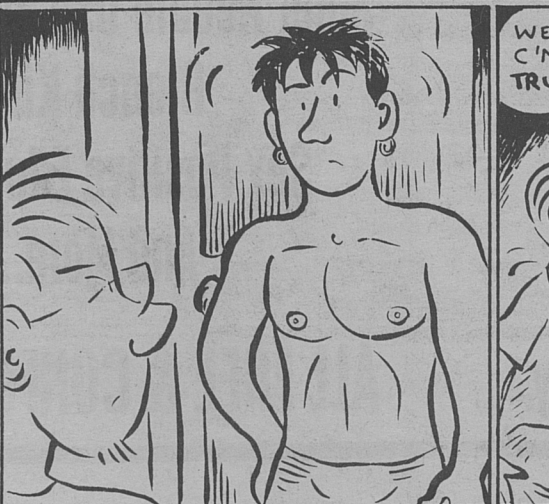

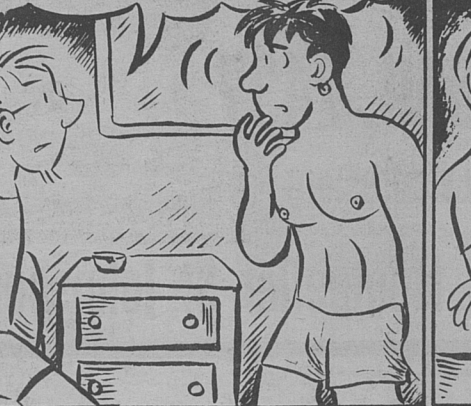
