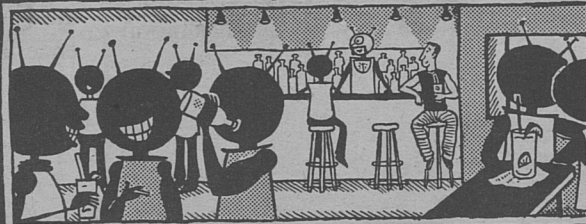

On Mars, no one uses cell phones. Their Antennae screw up The signal.



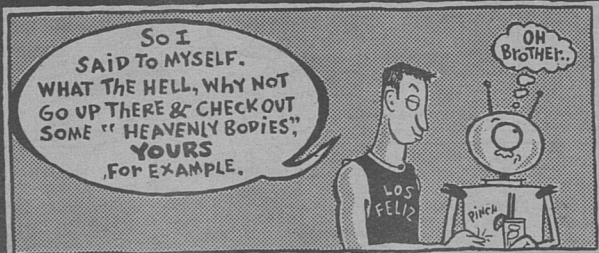
Ethan Green always says: "When your social life hits rock bottom, change rocks". Which is why he's here on Mars. At a cruise bar.

To be honest, these Martians aren't the bomb when it comes to looks. Still, it's a pleasant neighborhood spot. Guys gossiping with their friends.

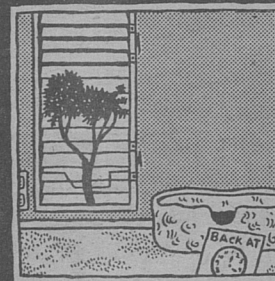

Lucy the Cat has been missing all morning.



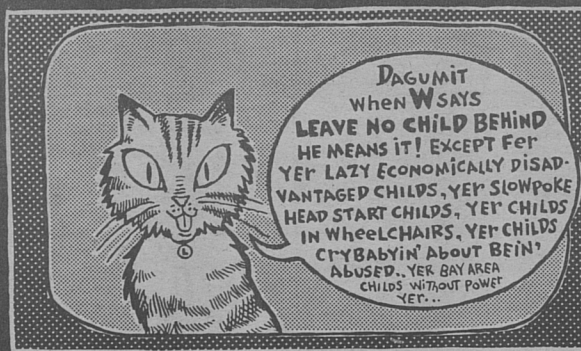
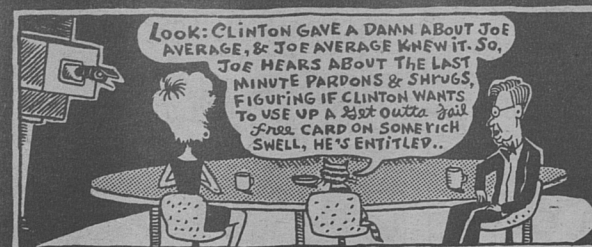
