Eastern Europe it is clear that we are really at the very early phases of the spread of HIV," Piot said.

More than 70 percent of the people with the virus that causes AIDS are in sub-Saharan Africa, the poorest region in the world. Global health officials worry the disease could spread as rapidly through a country such as India, with a population of 1 billion, as it has through South Africa, where 11 percent of the country's 43 million people are infected.

Gay Mayor

BERLIN - Berlin has a new mayor and he's one of us.

Klaus Wowereit, a 47-year-old lawyer, was voted into office by his fellow Social Democrats, forcing out a conservative who had held the post since reunification in 1990.

Wowereit presented himself to his party as the fresh force Berlin needs to clean up its finances, and also announced in his candidate's speech that he is gay, drawing lengthy applause.

At least until new elections this fall, Berlin will be run by a

coalition of the Social Democrats and the Greens party, mirroring the government on the national level, led by Chancellor Gerhard Schroeder.

Schroeder welcomed Wowereit's win Saturday, saying it opened "new prospects" for the capital.

Gays in Schools

WASHINGTON - A bill over federal education funding got hijacked over debate on gays in schools.

On a vote of 51-49, the Senate approved a proposal by Jesse Helms, R-N.C., to strip federal funding from any

school district that discriminates against the Boy Scouts or similar groups that "prohibit the acceptance of homosexuals." Opponents countered by winning swift approval of an amendment by Sen. Barbara Boxer, D-Calif., barring schools from denying access to any youth group, Boy Scouts included, on the basis of their views on sexual orientation.

Helms' amendment was triggered by last year's Supreme Court ruling that upheld a national Boy Scouts policy to ban gay members and leaders. He cited numerous examples in which local schools or school districts excluded Scouts from the use

of facilities.

Helms said his amendment was meant to combat "the organized lesbians and homosexuals in this country of ours." Democrats angrily denounced it, saying it would bind the hands of school boards trying to juggle access and Scout sponsorship with their states' anti-discrimination laws.

Boxer said the Scouts already were treated as other groups are and added: "I believe this amendment is unnecessarily gratuitous. It is hurtful to a group of people. It divides us again in this country."
