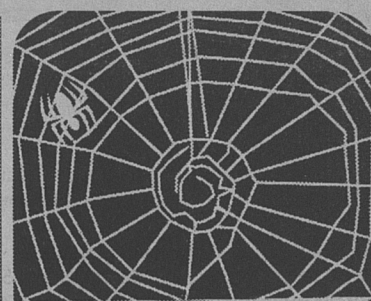

▼ The Transition to Parenthood for Lesbian Couples is a study aimed at better understanding lesbian couples' experiences as they make the transition to parenthood for the first time. A small sample (approximately 30) of lesbian couples will be interviewed both pre-baby (during the last trimester of pregnancy or a month prior to adoption) and post-baby, in order to understand how women's roles and relationships change as they welcome a new person into their lives. Specifically, interviews will involve questions about the decision to become parents, the process of becoming parents, and couples' expectations about and experience of balancing work and family issues. This research is important, as most of the research on the transition to parenthood is based on heterosexual couples! We need your input to help make changes at the policy level! Inclusion criteria are as follows: Lesbian women in committed relationships; Preparing to give birth to or adopt their FIRST CHILD (couples who are already pregnant or in the later stages of the adoption process); At least one partner is employed outside the home.
