The Laramie Project in Brattleboro The Laramie Project by Moises Kaufman and the Members of Tectonic Theater Project will be presented April 24 - April 27 by Wild Root Arts and the AIDS Project of Southern Vermont. The production will be performed by the Stella Adler/New York University Company. On October 7, 1998, a young gay man was discovered bound to a fence in the hills outside Laramie, Wyoming, savagely beaten and left to die in an act of brutality that shocked the nation. Matthew Shepard's death became a national

symbol of intolerance and hate. The Laramie Project chronicles the life of the town of Laramie in the year after the murder, using nine actors to embody more than sixty different people in their own words. The result is a complex portrayal that dispels simplistic media stereotypes and explores the depths to which humanity can descend and the heights of compassion of which we are capable. The Laramie Project will be presented on Thursday, April 24 at 7:30 pm; Friday, April 25 at 7:30 pm; Saturday, April 26 at 7:30 pm; and Sunday, April 27 at 2:00 pm.
