As of January 19th, the Health Center will offer Chittenden County's first Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) dental program. Two dental clinics, located at the Health Center's main facility and their Safe Harbor medical clinic for people experiencing homelessness, will provide access to dental care, regardless of ability to pay or insurance status. This program includes the county's first oral health sliding fee scale for low income uninsured residents with visits starting at \$5.00. For uninsured residents experiencing homelessness, preventive and restorative dental care services will be available at no cost.
