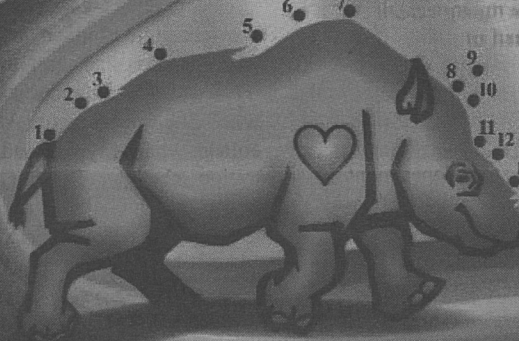

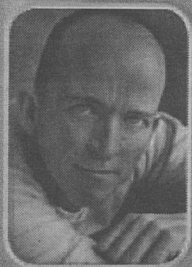


**The Purple Heart**
