 to West Lo-to-day and will enquire of the Stage driver
 who is Com-at Do Pomfret. Your letter was delayed by
 coming here & being remailed to Do Royalton where George
 & his wife are stopping for a few weeks on account of the
 traveling, this way we want more girls for house work &
 less for teachers, the girl that taught here two years ago
 went a few weeks ago to Mass and is doing house work tell
 your father we are all getting along about as usual except
 milking 21 cows so all have plenty to do, I have no help but
 a little girl at 12 years Yours with respect Mrs Abiel Whipple
