

Sharon Sept 10 1837

Dear Sister it is with pleasure that I
now embrace the opportunity of writing a few
lines to you to inform you of my health
which is verry good at present and hope
these few lines will find you enjoying the
same blessing I wrote to you about two
months since and have received no answer
and I did not know but that you
was sick for you wrote to me last you
was not verry well or you had not got
my letter so I thought I would write
to you again and I shall expect an
answer to this on the reception of it
without fail Sister Lydia is well and sends
her love to you Brothers Zephania and family
were well the last time that I heard
from them which was about six weeks since
Sister Lydia is a doing house work here she has
five shillings per week I have not heard
from Shepard since that I last wrote to
you although I have wrote to him I do not
know but he has gone to some other place
or it is I do not yet to him
