

Windsor March 11, 1857

Dear Sir,

This morning, on a review of our yesterday's work and in consequence of what we were informed relative to the dip of the rock at the east end of the State House, Judge Parker, Doctor Powers and myself concluded that it was best to limit the extension of the wings to twelve and a half feet. I proposed to send a message to you and wait your answer before instructing the architects so to prepare the plans, but the gentlemen thought it not material, inasmuch as the subject will come under consideration and be determined at our next meeting and the plans may be corrected if we see fit.
