

Windsor March 19. 1857

Dear Sir,

This morning, on a review of my yesterday's work and in consequence of what we were informed relative to the dip of the rock at the east end of the State House, Judge Parker, Doctor Powers and myself concluded that it was best to limit the extension of the wings to twelve and a half feet. I proposed to send a message to you and wait your answer before instructing the architect to prepare the plans, but the gentleman thought it more natural, inasmuch as the subject will come under consideration and be determined at our next meeting and the plans may be corrected if we see fit.
