Dear Sir

Yours of this days date is received. —

I understand that Dr Powers is to go to Boston tomorrow, but I do not know in what business. Probably he will see Silliman.

At the last session of the Legislature a board of Commissioners of the State Library was appointed of which we are members. As it is expressly provided that no compensation is to be allowed for services, the republic might receive no detriment if Gov. Fletcher would call the board together at Montpelier and attend himself some time this month, after the 25. I have no objection to hinder any
