I have  
this moment returned from Woodstock  
& find yours of yesterday. I have  
no means at hand of ascertaining  
the exact height at which the  
statue is to stand from the base of  
the building, but am quite sure it  
will be about one hundred & fifteen  
feet to the top of the railing. The  
columns are 36 feet, the architrave  
about 12 - the pediment about 10. &  
57 feet more to the top of the railing.  
The diameter upon the inside of the  
railing will be very near seven feet;  
but the nearest point in front at  
which the top of the railing can be  
seen I have at present no means of
