since I last wrote very little has transpired  
unusual about camp besides that two men  
of Co "F" of Burlington have died and are  
buried I dont know their names. Capt Bebe  
was sent home by Regt. My Co. are not  
as well as when I wrote but I have none  
who are very sick but quite a number  
who are a little unwell and in quarters
