March 7th 1863.

My Dear Sister:

I wrote you a letter this morning to send home by Sicut, Chamberlain, but this evening write you again to inform you of rather sad news.

I have just received a letter from Col. Andrews informing me of the death of Cyrus. Or at least I suppose it must be him. Col. Andrews enclosed a scrap cut from the Chicago Tribune of March 4th in these words, viz:

"Died at Memphis" - We learn that C. C. Farouham, formerly of this city, died at Memphis on last Wednesday night, of typhoid fever. He was literally among strangers, and was only identified after death by papers found in his possession."

The notice was evidently written by some one who knew him, but how he should be so entirely among strangers I cannot imagine. I have written to Col. Andrews to learn further particulars & also to the Editor of the Tribune to learn the name
