April 13<sup>th</sup> 1863.

Dear Mary:

I take time to write you in  
line this morning to let you know that  
we have not yet started, but shall  
probably go by tomorrow - when I do not  
yet know - I was lonesome enough last  
night & yesterday afternoon - I have not felt  
so blue since I left home. I was glad to  
hear from the Adjt. that you got on board  
the cars so nicely & hope you reached  
the Scott House without difficulty <sup>are well</sup> ~~and~~  
this morning.

I have no idea when we shall go but  
will write you every morning until I  
hear from you - Write me every day  
at present - direct as usual - & tell me  
how to direct to you.

Remember me to all the ladies &  
tell that we all miss them very much  
our table is quite lonesome -

I will write more when I do not  
feel in quite so much of a hurry -
