May 31st 1863 -

Sir:

As Field Officer of the Day for the forty eight hours ending this morning I submit the following report: ^{on morning of May 29th}

After guard mounting, I proceeded to the right wing of the picket line in company with the picket to assist them in relieving as it was the first time that either men or officers had been on the line. In the afternoon I visited the left wing of the line. I found the men generally attentive & doing ~~their duty~~ -

~~At night~~ ^{During} I visited the whole line, commencing at half past eight o'clock P. M., post by post returning at one o'clock - I found the men all on their posts and doing their duty. Nothing remarkable occurred on the line during the day -
