I take my pen this pleasant Sabbath morning to write a few lines in answer to your kind letter of the 1<sup>st</sup> of Feb which I rec'd the 25<sup>th</sup> your letter found me enjoying good health; I got a pass from the Doctor of the hospital and went up to regt to stop for 4 days - and while I was up there (the regt is at Brashear now) I rec'd your letter and the box you sent me; every thing came nice as a cotton hat. I hardly know how to express my thanks to you and the rest for the things you sent me - and for your kindness. I have just put on a pair of the socks you sent me. I shall have to send you and Mother something in this or my next letter to pay you for them,
