

Washington D.C.
Sept 5 1861
Sir I have the honor to enclose
to you your pay as Colonel 1st
Vermont Volunteers made out to the
15th August 1861 on which day the
regiment was mustered out.

You are entitled to your pay as
Colonel up to that time though you
are not debarred from drawing additional
pay as Brigadier General from the date
of your acceptance of that position.

On enquiry at the office of the Adjutant
General I find that you have not yet
accepted your appointment of "Brigadier
General". You are of course aware that your
pay in that rank commences from the
date of acceptance. If your acceptance is
dated before the 15th of August 1861 you can
draw the additional pay.

I hold a receipt given by
Lt Col Washburn for Five hundred
