

Wickville Ind. Sept. 13th 1862

My dear sister:

I will just drop a word to you this morning that you may not think I have forgotten you - Since I receive your last we have seen stirring times - I believe I got it at Hampton - we have been marching and countermarching ever since or the 7th Regt. has - and I tell last Monday about noon when the Surgeon left me here to recover a little - I wish it had been in that old Farm House in Lyndon instead of Wickville, but it could not be. I could tell you nothing of interest in all these marchings if I should undertake it and I do not
