Dear Mother I received
your letter of May 24th in due
season also two papers I was glad
to hear from you and to hear that
you are all well The boys have done
a large springs work more than I
should thought they could done
I should thought they would needed
help getting out the manure and
sowing the grain Our regt have
had another fight with Mosby
dont know how many men he
had nor how many our men had
I am going to tell the story as I heard it
Mosby tied a wire to a rail on the tra
ck having pulled out all the spikes
hid in the woods and waited for
the cars just before the engine got
