(last Sabbath eve) was all the letter
I rec^d from you during the past
week - I kinder thought I ought to

well, as you wrote me you was most
down sick, which in the army is a
good excuse - "Ferdie is going to get
well" you say - I have felt so all
the time - but you must take good
care of your own health darling -
We have not seen anything of the
Rebs yet, but have been looking
sharp for them for some days past,
we do not get any news of them yet -
The paymaster has just been up
and paid off the Regt. again, but
