July 30<sup>th</sup> 1863

My Dear wife

Your letter of last Sabbath came to me to day - only think of that, go four weeks with out a letter and then get them once in three days from you - I also got one from Ed from Sharon He said you was looking uncommonly well when he left, what a hard time mother must have of it taking care of Father. He probably will not stand it much longer.

There is a rumor in camp to day that we are to move tomorrow towards Fairfax C. H. and camp until the new men all get out, and I guess it is true.

Our boys are having a grand time now resting and visiting the old Ft.
