My Darling one

There is not the first thing new to write but yet I must continue to drop you a line every day or two just to let you "all is quiet on the Rapidan" if nothing more - We remain as when I wrote you last - We expected a move certain last night but it did not come -

From all I can learn today we shall take the "back track" within the next "thirty six hours" for it seems we are not to go to Richmond this way after all - but I probably can write you all the particulars by the next letter - I believe we shall fall clear back to Fairfax on the old line -
