My Darling wife

Last night after
dark we moved out and took the
camp occupied by a Brigade of the
fifth corps, and today have been
fixing up "winter quarters" again, but
it is pretty hard to tell how long it
will remain our quarters - The fifth
Corps have gone off to the left
of the line and we expect to
hear from them tomorrow - Our
Corps had yet here not arrived
yet so I can tell you nothing
new in regard to my case - Ed
came over last night and staid
with me until this morning - He
is looking finely and seems to
like the business very well - George is
in the Hospital at city point, but
I guess is not very sick - today
