Sept 26th / 63

Dear Father; Again I
take my pen & paper to inform
you of my whereabouts. Thurs-
day morning I drew a gun and
went at Alexandria & took the
cars for the field which proves
to be about 60 miles from Alex-
andria. We came to Owlpeper
by rail & then marched 4 miles
on a dusty road it me sweat
some but I stood it well, yes
better than I expected. When
we got here the Elmore boys
were by our sides in a few minu-
tes for the whole brigade all to-
gether & no guards between re-
giments & a chance to be together
as much as though it was one
