Camp Near Coal Harbor June 1864

Dear Parents & Brothers;

It is with pleasure that I seat myself this morning to pen a few lines to you in answer to yours dated May 27th which I recd the day I wrote my last, I am at in the hospital now, I left my Co. the day I wrote before, the sore on my heel the Dr. called an abscess, it is doing well now, it has matterated, I have not had my boot on since I left the Co. all the Stamps you sent come safe except the last, you said you put it in but I guess you forgot to put it in, I happen to have 50¢ on hand too, I think that the mail will be more regular about coming now, so that I shall get all that is sent in future.
