Near Richmond June 3rd 1862
Since I posted my letter home
this morning I rec^d one from
you and Louisa. The last I
rec^d from you about the money
was that you did not want
any more but would let it go
me. I replied that as you did
not want it yourself I would let
it lay where it is. I don't know
what you refer to in your last
about the cowardice of Co. E's
Officers at Lees Mills. — Before
the fighting commenced about
one third of Co. E. including
Lieut. Prigler and myself
were sent to the extreme right
of the right wing while the
balance of the Co were left near
