Camp Hinzlman May 13th 1863

My dear wife.

I received yours of the 3^o night before last. I had been to Washington again and got home in the night and found your very acceptable letter on my table. If you are suffering so for the want of rain I wish you could have some that we have, for it rains here most every day. We had a most terrific thunder storm yesterday.

I was in Washington on Friday last. Then the wounded from the last battle was brought in. and on Saturday I worked in the Campbell Hospital nearly all day dressing their wounds. which had not been dressed since the battle (the Sunday before) and your can
