

Camp Hingtman Jan 13^d 1863.

My dear wife.

I have just rec'd
your kind letter of the 8th inst.
I did expect to hear that you
had got into your new house, but
you will probably be in it by the time
this reaches you - A letter went
out for you yesterday that should
have gone last Tuesday - The Post
boy failed to come and get it.

You will see by the scrap
I send you that we have
fought our first battle. The
expectation was intense when our
men formed into line of
battle, but there was no noise
nor bustle - So ready and so much
are our men on the alert that
before the long roll was sounded
