Middleton W^t July 3rd 1863

My dear wife. ⁱⁿ I wrote you yesterday

at Frederick Junction, about 5 P.M.,
just on the eve of a march, or march-
ed till 10 o'clock, and went into
Camp in a most beautiful shower
and we layed in the open air all
night, and here I am writing in
open air in one of the most beau-
tiful valleys I ever saw, 13 miles from
Harpers Ferry, at what is called South
pass. It is now the only place the Rebs
can get to the Potomac to cross into Va
and as they are trying to get to this
pass we are here to cut them off, and
it would be nothing strange if we had
a blood fight before night, as the
Rebs are passing this way as fast as
they can. A company of our Cavalry scouts
yesterday captured 17 Rebs killed two wounded
one, destroyed two pontoon bridges, took the
Rebs over calculating to cut ours off, and
4 large wagons of valuable goods (mostly silk)
