

Camp in the field near Sulphur Springs Vt. Aug 23rd 1863

My dear wife:-

As every that concerns our interests
you I feel it my duty to inform you of an impor-
tant thing concerning my future. What I am about
to communicate to you I wish to be locked within
your own breast. There are to be raised two new
Reg't in Vermont and I am anxious for promotion
but I have never said a word to a single individual
about it. Night before last Dr Chiles as we lay
in our bunks talking over things in general he tra-
ns about these Reg't and said that I ought to have
one of them, and said he would write the Governor
about it. Which he has done. I will send you a
copy of the certificate to the Gov in my behalf
I do it more to show you how I stand with the
Reg't. Do not think I am vain nor foolish. But I am
proud of the esteem and respect shown me by my
fellow officers, I may not need, but I shant con-
cerning myself by trying. You may ask why Mr Jewell's
name is not with the rest. The Col is in Vermont
on a sick leave. But I know just how he feels about
