Dear Sister —

I rec^d your letter
a day or two since but have been
so busy I have not found time to
answer it before. For a few days
past we have had Cattle and
forenoon & afternoon & evenings,
so our time has been
pretty well taken up. I wrote you
in regard to Bloughts capture the
next day after it happened, there is
nothing new in regard to it, more
than you have seen in the papers.
Therebs did a pretty smart thing,
took a Brig. Gen. without firing
a gun. — The Regts here
have all been at work to
day digging rifle pits & preparing
the station for defence, as a
