

Camp at Union Mills Va.

Sunday Apr. 19th 1863.

Dear Sister

I rec^d a letter from you to day so will answer this evening tho' I have nothing in particular to write only that we are still at our old Camp & likely to remain here for the present. It seems from what we can learn that at the time we expected to move, they intended to send us to Suffolk Va. but finally concluded to take Reg^{ts} from nearer Washington. We have got our tents back & are living again. —

I'm not yet as black as I was last summer when I came home, but when I do come home this time I'll bet I'll show you a black Jo, for the weather is getting warm & the sun just beginning to tan
