

Camp at Union Mills Pa.

May 31st 1863

Dear Sister -

I have not rec'd a letter from you since I last wrote, but as I have not written for a number of days, I will write this evening as I have nothing else to do in particular. -

The 12th Reg^t relieved our Co. at Bristol Station the day I wrote you last; it was unexpected to us, as we were expecting to stay there some time, however here we are back in camp, but don't like it half as well as we did to be out there. -

I went down to Washington the next day after we were relieved, & have just got back to night; I have bid good bye to W - until we go there on our way home. It was rather necessary for me to go this time as I was very much in need of some articles of clothing; now I think I am supplied with every thing I shall want in the military line until I enlist again. I got this time a hat, buggy
