Key Darling

We have had another little brush to-day. Started out to Lewisville in force to forage this morn. Got over a hundred loads hay & corn &c, drove cattle, flock sheep. I assisted Mr. Proctor, as only part of our regt. went out, the remainder being on picket. Just as we started the last load home, the rebels began to toss in their shells, which was duly responded to by our battery till they shut their mouths & retreated.
