Camp at Fairfax Sta. Va.  
March 18<sup>th</sup> 1862

I should get a letter to day but  
none came. We are having a very  
dull time now - a portion of the  
men are digging rifle pits -

The weather is very unpleasant -  
storms about the whole time -

I dont have any particular business  
to do & yet am quite busy all the  
time - Am very well except a  
slight cold in my head -

Guess if you want delicate I couldn't  
get along without you - Aint a  
man foolish to get so attached to  
some little woman that he cant  
along without her - Would you if  
you were a man?

Do you know where Jim Leisters  
is now - Wonder if he has been able  
to find any religion that will suit  
both himself & other folks -

Have you got my trunk at Ashua?  
If so I wish you would please look  
in it for a letter from C. C. White  
directing me to pay Col. Proctor \$10.
