

Williamsburg Va May 7th 1862

Dear Mother

Yours of the 8th come to hand last night it found me as usual and an other Union Victory is gained since my last Yorktown is worse and about two hundred prisoners I will try to give you a history of the battle as far as I know last Sabbath morn Chauncy Knill & myself waked up the sun had not risen but it was a splendid morning we all three took a walk down to the batteries all was still not a gun to be heard we looked over to the Canvass works and all was still there we went back to the company nothing going on unusual yet the boys fall in for breakfast stop what else we hear fall in under arms is the order we fall in without breakfast and the Regt starts & marches down when we three had been there was General Smith and staff General Brooks and all the Officers of rank the
