Dear Sister,

Yours. No. 6. Came to hand  
in due time and was gladly received  
by me as usual. Now I will try and  
answer it - and give you a short  
history of the proceedings for the  
last few days. Last Friday morning  
we were quietly laying in our old  
Camp near White Oak Church and  
expected to stay there for a  
while at least - but a little  
after noon we were ordered to  
pack up and fall in and in a  
very few moments we were on  
our way for the river where we  
arrived about 5. P. M. and before  
dark the most of our brigades were  
across the River about one and a  
half miles below the City of Fredericks<sup>burg</sup>
