Camp of the Co. Regt. W. Vols.  
Near Warrenton, Va. Aug 6.

Dear Sister

Your Letter No. 11, came  
to hand Aug 1<sup>st</sup> and was received  
with pleasure as your Letters  
always are by me and if the  
writing does not look so nice  
as I once did it is just as  
welcome and I am never bothered  
to read them. I was glad to know  
that you were all well and this  
leaves me the same.

The weather is very hot and has  
been so for the last week or  
two so that we have been glad  
to keep in the shade the most  
of the time when we can do so.  
Yesterday we moved camp about  
two miles and it was so hot  
that we came near melting at the
