Co. Va Dec, 4<sup>th</sup> 1863

Dear Sister and folks at "Home".

As I

have not received a letter from any of you since the one Mother wrote the 4<sup>th</sup> of last month I concluded I would wait no longer but would write you again. I am well as usual and hope that these few lines will find you all well as usual. I received the box, which you sent me, yesterday and was very glad to get it - as I had begun to think that I should never see it - but it has come and everything safe and it seems nice to get a taste of old Vermont - Butter & Cheese once more but the best of all was those nice shirts, Drawers, Gloves, and Socks

I like my shirts very much indeed they were made so much better than I could have told you how
